


Being One in the Body of Christ

Paul talks about how Jesus brings together all humanity as one; each as separate individuals but together, one family. Christ unites us all; all who believe in Jesus are loved by God and saved through their faith. No diversity in opinions or practices should separate us from one another, and yet, in the years since Paul's letter to Christians in Corinth, the church has split time and time again due to a variety of arguments and differences of opinion. Human weakness and free will have resulted in Christ's Church being what it is today.

God made us to be intelligent beings with an ability to question and figure out, and the ability to formulate our own opinions and ways of worship, so I don't want to sound like I'm saying diversity is bad. What I want to do is encourage all who are reading this to strive for unity; to focus more on our similarities as followers of Christ than our

good; for the betterment






Book club will meet on Thurs, June 13th @ 6:30 p.m.
